Covid 19 Symptoms and Testing

Please be aware of Covid 19 symptoms:

- A high temperature
- A new, continuous cough
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste

Children should not attend school if presenting with any of these symptoms. Should you have any of these symptoms, a PCR test should be taken.

Lateral Flow Tests (results in 30 mins) should only be used when there are no symptoms. If your child has any of the below symptoms, a Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) Tests (at a testing site or home postal tests) should be used.
